Subject : Curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutional – regarding.

Reference : Letter of UGC bearing No. F-1-15/2009/(ARC)pt-III dated 16.09.2022.

Sir,

New academic session 2022-23 is going to commenced and RUHS wishes best of luck for a wonderful start of the new academic session to you, worthy faculty members and students of your college, may each one of you grow as an individual and as a team.

Ragging is an unlawful activity which is liable to serious consequences. We are proud of the fact that our university aims at maintaining a healthy and congenial academic environment at its campus as well as all affiliated & constituent colleges. UGC and RUHS had issued instructions regarding curbing the menace of ragging in the higher educational institutions from time to time. In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 88712009, the UGC had "*Regulations on Curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009*" which are mandatory to be followed by all the colleges. The said regulations are available on the website of UGC i.e. www.ugc.ac.in

As multiple mechanisms are required to ensure a ragging-free campus, UGC has recommended action steps vide referred letter according to which you are requested to set up anti-ragging mechanism by way of adequate publicity through various mediums; constitution of anti-ragging committee and anti ragging squad, setting up of anti ragging cell, installing CCTV cameras at vital points, alarm bells etc. Regular interaction and counseling with the students, identification of trouble-triggers, mention of Anti-ragging warnings in the institution's prospects and information booklets/brochures shall be ensured. Surprise inspection of hostels, students accommodation, canteens, rest cum recreational rooms, toilets, bus stands and any other measure which would augur well in preventing/quelling ragging and any uncalled for behavior / incident shall be under taken. The students and the parent/guardian community may also be made aware of the anti-ragging helpline, anti-ragging website, anti-ragging monitoring agency.

You are requested to hold the workshops, seminars on eradication of ragging in college and are also requested to display Anti Ragging posters at all the prominent places of your college like admission centre, departments, library, canteen, hostel, common facilities etc. Other necessary steps, deemed proper by you, for curbing the menace of ragging should also be taken under intimation to RUHS. You are requested to take legal action in serious cases, involving local police authorities.

Further, an online compliance of anti-ragging regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institution, 2009 must be submitted at www.antiragging.in It must be ensured that each students and every parent submits an online undertaking for every academic year at www.antiragging.in and www.amanmovement.org You are requested to submit a letter to RUHS confirming that the guidelines & regulations of UGC regarding anti-ragging have been followed and the compliance regarding online undertaking have been made by your institution.

Please ensure the strict compliance of the aforesaid regulations. Any violation of these regulations will be viewed seriously. If any institution fails to take adequate steps to prevent or does not act in accordance with these regulations of rails to punish perpetrators of incidents of ragging suitable, it will attract punitive action against itself by UGC as well as by RUHS.
