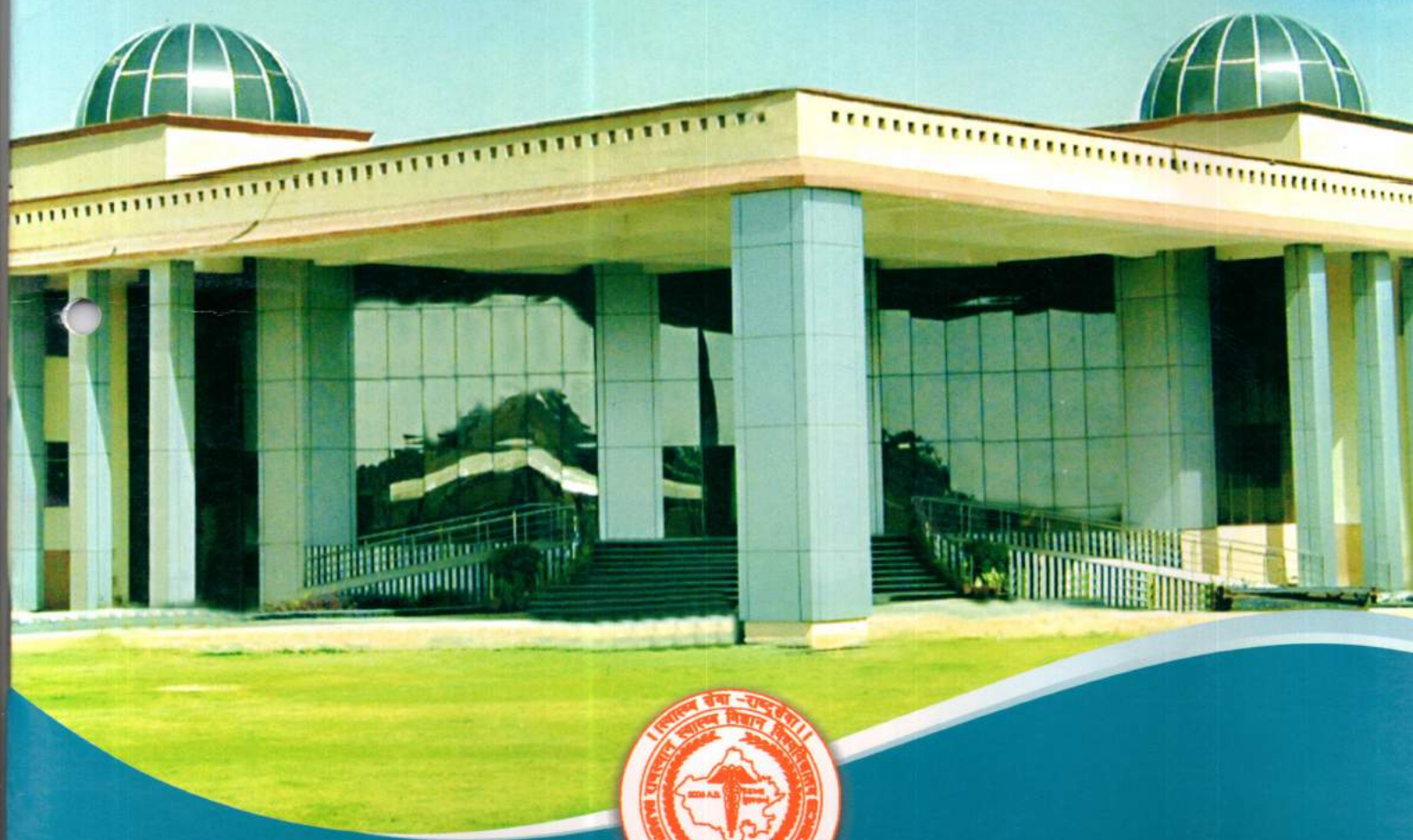

## *The Beginning*

The Rajasthan University of Health Sciences came into existence under the act The Rajasthan University of Health Sciences Act, 2005 (Act No. 1 of 2005) the His Excellency Governor of Rajasthan gave her assent on the 25 of February, 2005. The R.U.H.S. started its functioning on 1st April, 2005. Dr. P.P.S. Mathur, M.Ch. (Neuro Surgery), M.S. (General Surgery) took over the charge as 1st Vice Chancellor of this University on the day of its functioning i.e. 1st April, 2006.

University took over the old building at B-1, Sawai Ram Singh Road, Opp. SMS Hospital, Jaipur in the month of June, 2006 and shifted in the new magnificent, beautifully decorated building at Sector-18, Pratap Nagar, Jaipur in the month of December, 2007.

## *The Thought*

Since the vistas of medical education rolls out beyond medicine to Pharmacy, Dentistry and Nursing, subsequently Health Sciences. There is a need to create an institute which may fulfill not only the need of the hour but take care of emerging challenges in time to come. Keeping this view in mind, State Government of Rajasthan enacted and passed an Act "The Rajasthan University of Health Sciences Act, 2005" (Act No. 1 of 2005)". in February 2005.

## The Objectives

- (a) To disseminate and advance knowledge in medicine and dentistry and to ensure efficient and systematic instruction, teaching, training and research therein;
- (b) To provide for a multipurpose super-speciality hospital and trauma centre by upgrading the existing institutions and to establish them as a centre of excellence;
- (c) To treat patients in its hospitals;
- (d) To establish a nursing training centre;
- (e) To administer, manage and control the hospitals, including the Rehabilitation and Artificial Limb Centre, Jaipur, pathological laboratories, diagnostic centres and blood banks;
- (f) To establish a tele-medicine department;
- (g) To develop a reproductive and population control research institute;
- (h) To develop a genetics department;
- (i) To develop an environment and pollution control institute;
- (j) To develop transfusion medicine;
- (k) To develop a nutrition research centre;
- (l) To develop gene-therapy, molecular biology, robotic surgery, bio-informatics, organs transplantation, bio-technology, immunology and clinical epidemiology and other facilities in medicine and dentistry; and
- (m) To establish a centre for imparting training to teachers.

## *Construction of RUHS Building*

Building of Administrative Block of RUHS has been constructed by RSRDC. For this, an administrative sanction of Rs. 520/- lac was issued by the State Government. Rs. 420/- lac were released to the P.D. account of RSRDC in 2005-06. On the progress of construction work Rs. 80.00 lac were released to RSRDC in the current financial year. Balance of Rs. 20.00 lac is available in the P.D. account of RUHS which will be released to RSRDC on receipt of final accounts.
