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The Inception

The RUHS was formed in the year 2005 as per the Government of Rajasthan Act, THE RAJASTHAN UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES ACT, 2005 (Act No. 1 of 2005) to bring about co-ordination and co-operation between various educational and training institutions of modern medicine and other systems of Medicine, Dentistry and allied health sciences and to promote research in all fields of health sciences.

The Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur is a relatively young University of the country which came into existence on 31st March, 2006. Before its inception, the medical faculty was a part of the University of Rajasthan. There has been a continuous increase in the number of affiliated colleges and the academic scenario has reached new horizons. The University is now in the process of introducing new courses, job oriented courses and intensive research oriented programs.


Presently there are six faculties in University viz; Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Nursing, Physiotherapy & Occupational Therapy and Paramedical Sciences. 

- To acquire additional resources viz. land & manpower for further strengthening the infrastructure and to establish University Library, Activity Centre, Centre of Innovation of Preventive, Promotive & Rehabilitative Medicine, Sports Complex, Institute of Pharmacy, Nursing, Paramedical & Dentistry, Institute of Biotechnology, Residential Buildings for Doctors, Nurses, Residents, Faculties & Hostels etc. It will be a comprehensive & integrated medical education campus.
- ☆ To strengthen the existing website facility of RUHS for effective usage.
- To establish and develop a Centre of Nano-Medicine & Stem Cell Research Lab with the financial support from Biotechnology Department of Government of India and Department of Science & Technology, Government of Rajasthan.
- * To develop an institute to provide training in Disaster Management.

- Vide order No. F.27(41)ME/Gr.1/91 Pt.-1 Jaipur dated 22.09.2006 of Medical & Health (Gr.1) Department, Government of Rajasthan all medical, dental colleges and institutions notified vide notification mentioned above have been temporarily affiliated with the Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur with effect from 01.10.2006.
- The Government of Rajasthan Medical Education (Gr.1) Department vide Notification No. F.27(41)ME/Gr.1/91 Pt-I Jaipur dated 11.12.2006 terminated the territorial jurisdiction of the University of Rajasthan, Jaipur and Rajasthan Technical University, Kota over the 28 Pharmacy Colleges/Institutions with effect from 11.12.2006.
- Vide order No. F.27(41)ME/Gr.1/91 Pt-I Jaipur dated 11.12.2006 of Medical & Health (Gr.I) Department, Government of Rajasthan all Pharmacy Colleges/Institutions notified vide notification mentioned above have been temporarily affiliated with the Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur with effect from 11.12.2006.
- Vide order No. F.16(13)ME/Gr.1/2006 Jaipur dated 16.08.2011 In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 6 of the Rajasthan University of Health Sciences Act, 2005 (Act No. 1 of 2005) and in consultation with the Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur, the State Government, hereby declares the Government Dental College and Hospital, Jaipur as Constituent College of the Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur.
- Government of Rajasthan in the year 2014 issued order to establish a constituent medical college under RUHS from the academic session 2014–15 with an annual intake of 100 seats of MBBS course. Govt. RDBP Jaipuria Hospital Jaipur was declared an attached hospital of this new medical college and permission was also granted by the state government for upgradation of this hospital as 300 bedded hospital.











